After years of planning and preparation, the Charitable Pharmacy of Central Ohio, Inc. is ready to open its doors! While we will accept patients on a walk-in basis, the best way to ensure that your clients will qualify for service with the Charitable Pharmacy is to pre-screen them according to our criteria, make an appointment with us, and give them a voucher to bring with them to the Pharmacy. Let me explain...

In order to qualify with the Charitable Pharmacy, patients must reside in Franklin County, have an income at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Line, and be uninsured or underinsured, meaning the patient has no prescription coverage or cannot afford his/her prescription co-pays. If the patient meets all of these qualifications, we ask that you make an appointment for that person with the Charitable Pharmacy by calling 614-227-0301, or send an email to charitablepharmacy@gmail.com with the patient's name and contact information.

Patients should bring proof of residence and income to their appointment at the Pharmacy (see attached qualification guidelines), along with the voucher we have provided. If a patient does not have proper documentation of residency or income, we ask that you send them with a letter from your organization, on official letterhead, with your contact information, attesting to the patient's identity, residency, and level of income.
